#### 6. Consent Agenda

- A. Change of GIS Software Provider.
  - i. General Manager presented information regarding the change of GIS software providers to Esri Inc. The new software will provide improved performance, better controls of data input with a costs savings of \$30,000 over three years as compared to previous GIS software provider.
